**Friday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2017**

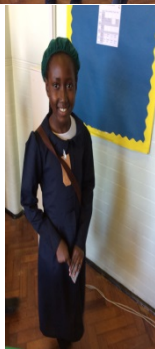
